



Having regard to Article VI(2)(b) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Constitutional Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina at its 48<sup>th</sup> plenary session held on 7 and 8 July 2008 adopted the following

**DECISION**  
**on Amendments to the Rules of the Constitutional Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina**

**Article 1**

In Article 88 paragraph 2 of the Rules of the Constitutional Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina (*Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina* no. 60/05),” the following words shall be added after the words “people” and read: “ If at that time, only one judge, who is a member of that constituent people, is present, the Constitutional Court may, at the plenary session, appoint a judge, a member of any constituent peoples to discharge the functions of the President until a second member of that constituent people has taken office or until the end of his/her term“.

**Article 2**

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption and shall be published in the *Official Gazette of BiH, the Official Gazettes of the Entities and Brčko District of BiH*.
